COURSE WARNINGS:

- Semi submerged mussel culture rafts are south of the BMYS jetty.
- Keep seaward of all Cardinal Marks. A reef runs from West Cardinal Mark Northeast to a rock cairn marker near the shoreline.

BRIEFING NOTES

CHART: AUS 155 WGS 84

RULES: Current Yachting Victoria, as close as practical.

ELECTRONIC AIDS: Radar, GPS and other electronic navigational aids are allowed.

OFFICIAL TIME: Telstra **1194**, GPS Time

OFFICIAL START TIME: 0900 Hours.

No Boats are allowed to cross the start line 5 minutes prior to official start time.

IDENTIFICATION: Club Burgee and <u>regulation event numbers MUST be displayed</u>.

RADIO WATCH: Beaumaris Base will monitor calls on 27.91 Mhz & VHF 73.

RADIO CHECK IN: All Boats must check in to Beaumaris Base Prior to race start by 0855

DATUM POINT: 1.0 Cable 145 degrees True from the seaward end of the BMYS jetty.

(37 59.55 S 145 02.75 E WGS 84)

START / FINISH LINE: A line 145 degrees True through a flagpole on the seaward end of the BMYS

jetty to three red lights on the clubhouse roof.

START PROCEDURE: All vessels MUST keep at least 1 cable clear of start line after Official Start

Time unless actually starting. Vessels crossing the start line in either direction

after Official Start Time shall be deemed to have started. STARTING

VESSELS MUST be on course at nominated speed, 0.5 cables before start

line.

START TIMES: Start times together with a running sheet will be emailed on receipt of an entry.

WEATHER WARNING: In the event of adverse weather conditions contact the event organisers or

BMYS on 9589-5156 after 0730 hrs on the day. It is the responsibility of each skipper to withdraw at any time if he / she considers that the SAFETY of his /

her vessel or crew may be in JEOPARDY.

MOORING ZONE: Special dispensation has been granted for this event permitting competitors to

exceed the 5-knot speed restriction in the mooring zone adjacent to BMYS.

RETIRING VESSELS: Any vessel retiring <u>MUST</u> advise BMYS on the day by phone or radio.

BACK UP DATE: TBA

NOMINATED SPEEDS: 5, 6, 7.5, 10, 12 Knots, Other by arrangement with organisers.

TACK-TRACKER:

Note:

This event will be using & scoring with **Tack Tracker** program & GPS Data logger Tracking devices.

Time checks will be calculated using unidentified gates, not traditional landmarks along the course route.

Penalties apply for missing the start gate (100 Points), missing course gates (50 Points), total maximum gate penalty is capped at 300 points.

One Tack Tracker data logger will be issued to each vessel.


It will be the responsibility of the skipper of each vessel to return the data logger in the same condition it was received, on the same day as the intended race is scheduled.

Tack Tracker Data loggers will be available from the club office on the same day as the event from 8.30 am.

Arrangements will be made on race day to get data loggers to visiting boats arriving to the club on water.

Each Data logger issued will be in a "ready for rally" condition, requiring no setup or adjustment from entrants. In the unlikely event of a data logger failing to capture rally data for any reason, BMYS will not be held responsible for that vessels results.

Each data logger must be located at the helm.
